

# TLILIC0003 LICENCE TO OPERATE A FORKLIFT TRUCK (3 Day Course)

## Course Overview

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to operate a Forklift Truck safely.

Forklift truck means a powered industrial truck equipped with Lifting media made up of a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other arms that can be raised 900mm or more above the ground, but does not include a pedestrian-operated truck or a pallet truck.

A person performing this work is required to hold a forklift truck High Risk Work (HRW) Licence.

This unit requires a person operating a forklift truck to plan the work, prepare for the work/task, perform work/task checks on a forklift truck, shift loads in a safe manner and safely shut down and secure equipment after completing operations.

## Course Topics

- Australian and industry standards and Commonwealth, state or territory WHS/OHS legislation and code of practices
- Forklift Truck types, characteristics, technical capabilities and limitations
- Hierarchy of Control
- Operational, maintenance and basic diagnostic procedures
- Risk control measures including barricades and traffic control
- Basic Calculations and techniques for calculating safe working loads including forklift load charts, control labels, forklift warning decals
- Identify hazards associated with the operation of the forklift truck, assess risks and put into place effective hazard prevention/control measures for those hazards identified
- Organisational and workplace standards, requirements, policies and procedures for conducting operations with the forklift
- Compliance with electrical permits including but not limited to adequate lighting, excavation safeguards, pedestrian control, safety tags on electrical switches/isolators, use of PPE gear
- Procedures for the recording, reporting and maintenance of workplace records and information

This unit of competency is appropriate for existing and potential employees of a broad cross section of the Australian industry, who are working in an operational role, at worksites including; civil construction, warehousing, coal mining, drilling, extractive industries or metalliferous mining.
